## SELECT COMMITTEE ON DELIBERATE ONLINE FALSEHOODS – CAUSES, CONSEQUENCES AND COUNTERMEASURES

The Select Committee on Deliberate Online Falsehoods – Causes, Consequences and Countermeasures has received a total of 164 written representations over seven weeks. The written representors include media organisations, technology companies, foreign and local academics and experts, commentators, and members of the public.

- To date, the Select Committee has decided to invite 79 individuals and organisations to give oral evidence at its public hearings, which will commence on 14 March 2018 in Parliament. These individuals and organisations were selected to represent a cross section of different stakeholder groups, or because their written representations require further clarification.
